Q: How much does the handle extend?

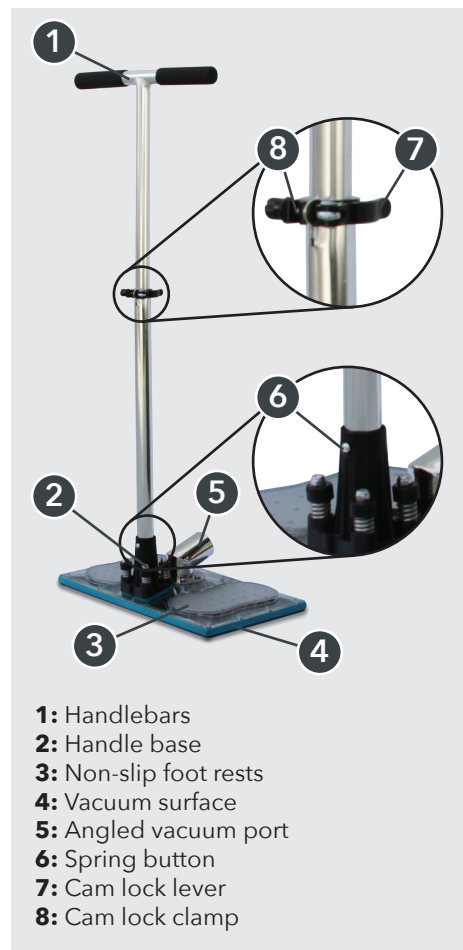
A: The handle extends from 24" - 38" from the ground.

Q: What are the dimensions of extracting surface?

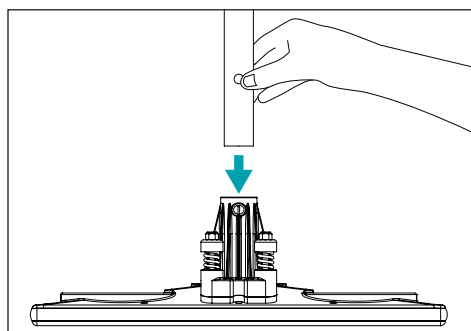
A: The extracting surface is 16.5" x 9.5".

Q: What size hose cuffs are compatible with the SOS PRO?

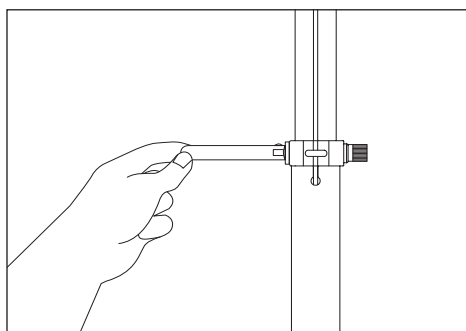
A: You can use 1.5" or 2" hose cuffs with the SOS PRO.



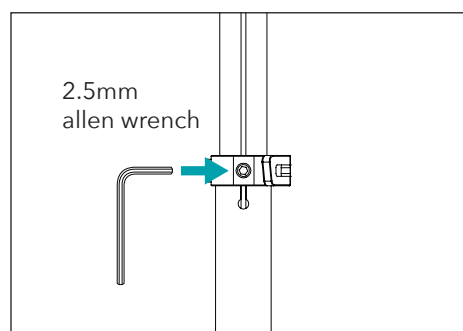
Assembling the SOS PRO



1. Press in the spring button and slide the handle into the handle base. Make sure the spring button lines up with the hole. It will snap into place.

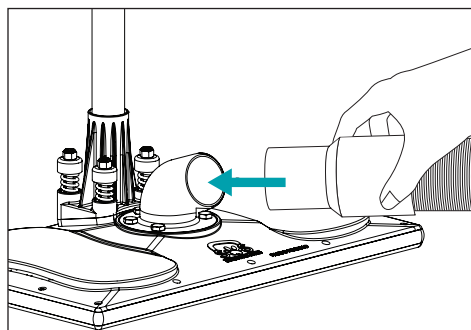


2. With the handle in place, pull the cam lock lever outward to loosen the clamp. Slide the handle up to desired height and press the lever back inward to tighten.

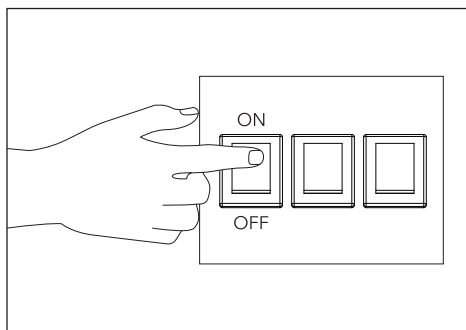


OPTIONAL: To ensure the handle will not move, tighten the set screw into the handle.

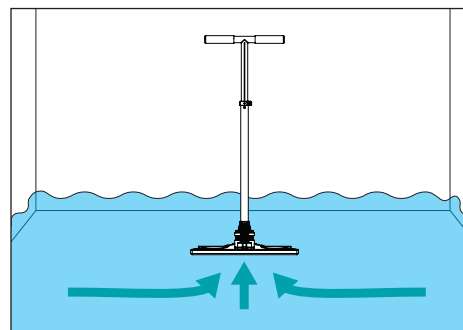
Using the SOS PRO



1. Connect vacuum hose from a portable or truck-mounted extractor. 2" cuffs will slide over the vacuum port and 1.5" cuffs will slide inside.



2. Turn the extractor ON.



3. If there is standing water, place the SOS PRO in the center of the room to remove the standing water down to the carpet level.

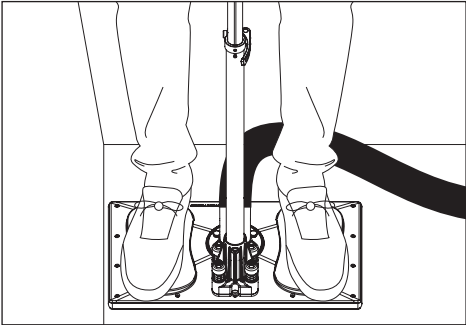

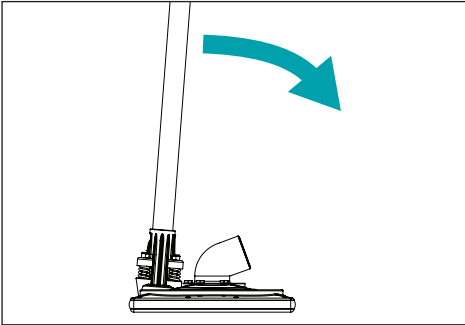

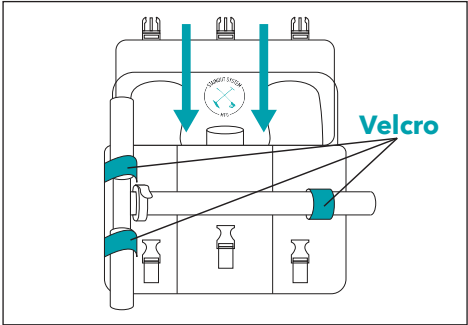
Using the SOS PRO (cont.)



4. Place the SOS PRO in a starting point, usually a corner in the room and stand on it for about 5-30 seconds to extract water from the carpet and pad.



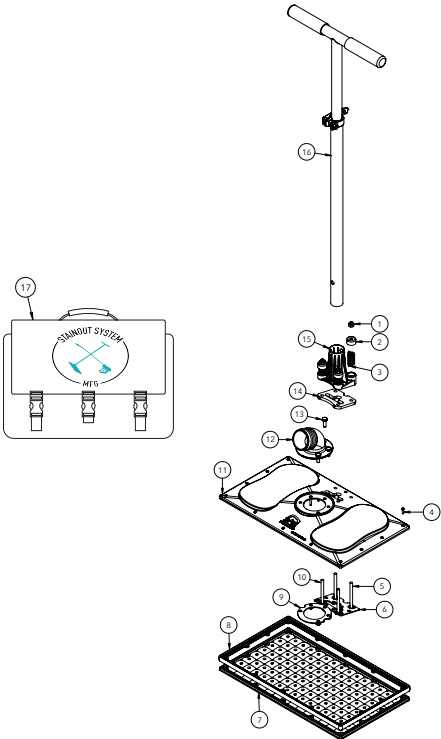
5. When you're ready to move to a new position, pull the handle back to release suction. Move the SOS PRO to a position that is directly adjacent to, but not overlapping, the previous extraction position.



6. After you have covered the entire extraction area, test the carpet to see if further extraction is required. When you are finished using the SOS PRO, store it in the included travel bag as shown above.

Warranty

Your SOS PRO is designed to give you years of reliable service.

If you are unable to determine the cause or solution to a problem contact your distributor or StainOut System for assistance.

StainOut System warrants the SOS PRO to be free from defects in material or workmanship for two years from the date of purchase.

During the warranty period, StainOut System will, at its option repair or replace components which prove to be defective. This warranty does not provide for replacement of complete units due to defective components. Any costs for transportation or related service labor are not covered in this warranty. Replacement parts are warranted only for the remainder of the original warranty period.
