Q: To what height does the handle extend?


 $\pmb{\mathsf{A:}}$ The handle height is adjustable between 24" - 38" from the ground.

Q: What are the dimensions of the extracting surface?

A: The extracting surface is 16.5" x 9.5".


Q: What size hose cuffs are compatible with the SOS PRO?

A: The SOS PRO is compatible with 1.5" or 2" hose cuffs.




- 1: Handlebars

- 10: Cam lock lever


Assembling the SOS PRO



1. Press in the spring button and slide the handle into the handle base. Make sure the spring button lines up with the hole. It will snap into place. **NOTE:** The handle may fit tightly on the first installation but it will loosen up over time.




lock lever outward to loosen the clamp. Slide the handle up to desired height and press the lever back inward to tighten.




2. With the handle in place, pull the cam 3. Using the included velcro straps, attach the hose and valve fitting assembly to the handlebars with the valve facing outward.


Using the SOS PRO



1. Connect vacuum hose from a portable or truck-mounted extractor. 2" cuffs will slide over the vacuum port and 1.5" cuffs will slide inside. Connect a solution line from the extractor to the quick connect fitting on the handle.



2. Turn the extractor's vacuum(s) and pump



3. If there is standing water, place the SOS PRO in the center of the room to remove the standing water down to the carpet lev-






Using the SOS PRO (cont.)




4. Place the SOS PRO in a starting point, usually a corner in the room and stand on it for about 5-30 seconds to extract water from the carpet and pad.



5. To saturate an area with solution, turn the flow valve to the open position. Turn to the closed position to stop solution flow.



6. When you are ready to move to a new position, pull the handle back to release suction. Move the SOS PRO to a position that is directly adjacent to, but not overlapping, the previous extraction position.



7. After you have covered the entire extraction area, test the carpet to see if further extraction is required. When you are finished using the SOS PRO, store it in the included travel bag as shown above.

Limited Warranty

The SOS PRO has been designed for and by the pros to give you years of superior performance. StainOut System warrants the SOS PRO to be free from defects in material or workmanship for one year from the original date of purchase.

During the one-year warranty period, StainOut System will, at its discretion, repair or replace components which prove to be defective. The replacement of complete units due to defective components is not covered under this warranty. Costs for transportation or related service labor are not covered by this warranty. Parts and components which have been replaced are warranted only for the remainder of the original warranty period.

Defects resulting from misuse, abuse, lack of maintenance, unauthorized modification, chemical incompatibility, or exposure to freezing temperature conditions are not covered under this warranty. This warranty does not apply to wear parts and components which require replacement as a result of ordinary usage.
